

Anker Reference Value Annual Update¹ Rural Gabon 2022

Living Wage

(USD 313)

This report updates the Anker Living Wage Reference Value for rural Gabon to 2022. The updated values for 2022 are: (i) Anker Gross Living Wage of: CFA 205,446 (USD 329), comprised of a Net living Wage of CFA 195,501 (USD 313), plus mandatory deductions of CFA 9,965 (USD 16). Inflation in this period was 3.33%² and it increased the net living wage. Without accounting for inflation, the living wage estimated in 2021 would not be sufficient for families to have a basic but decent standard of living in 2022, because the purchasing power of the living wage would have decreased. Social security contributions and complementary salary tax were calculated using the most up-to-date tax laws.³ The living wage Reference Value for 2021 was CFA 200,770 (USD 369) for in the original report⁴, comprised of a net living wage (i.e. take-home pay) of CFA 189,197 (USD 347) per month plus CFA 11,573 (USD 21), which would need to be paid by law as social security contributions and complementary salary tax on the living wage.
